Overview

La Salle Prep seeks a Director of Faith / Campus Minister for the academic year beginning in August 2022. The Director of Faith / Campus Minister under the direction of the Vice Principal of Student Life is responsible for prayer and sacramental life of the school including liturgies, prayer services and student and faculty retreat programs. This position includes teaching 2 religious studies courses.

Necessary Skills and Requirements

- Practicing Catholic
- Understanding of Lasallian mission and core values of our institution
- Experience in Catholic education
- Understanding of and commitment to culturally responsive practice
- High school experience strongly preferred
- Master's degree in related field is preferred
- Some evenings and weekends required

Essential Duties

- Organize and implement grade level retreats that foster student faith development, spirituality, and belonging
- Organize and facilitate prayer experiences for entire community including several schoolwide liturgies
- Collaborate with Student Life team (Director of Community, Director of Service, and Director of Inclusion) to foster and develop student leadership and voice
- Support Leadership elective, led by Director of Community
- Recognize and celebrate diversity of school community

- Facilitate conversations and opportunities for student vocations, including district level programming
- Collaborate with Religious Studies department on faith formation and ongoing chapel days.
- Communicate with and serve as liaison to Archdiocese of Portland
- Support administrative team in times of crisis and/or grief

Teaching Duties

- Collaborate with Religious Studies department to create curriculum that is relevant and engaging and aligned to departmental goals and outcomes
- Utilize PowerSchool and Schoology to communicate student progress and learning resources
- Engage students in critical thinking, inquiry and analysis
- Demonstrate professional and personal commitment to promoting diversity, equity, inclusion and belonging
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- Demonstrate cultural competency, a respect for and understanding of diverse cultures and experiences in the classroom and greater community Participate in professional learning teams and schoolwide professional development initiatives
- Monitor student progress and provide feedback using frequent formative and end of unit summative assessments
- Maintain accurate student grades, records and/or portfolios
- Build and maintain positive relationships with students and staff
- Communicate effectively and consistently with parents and colleagues
